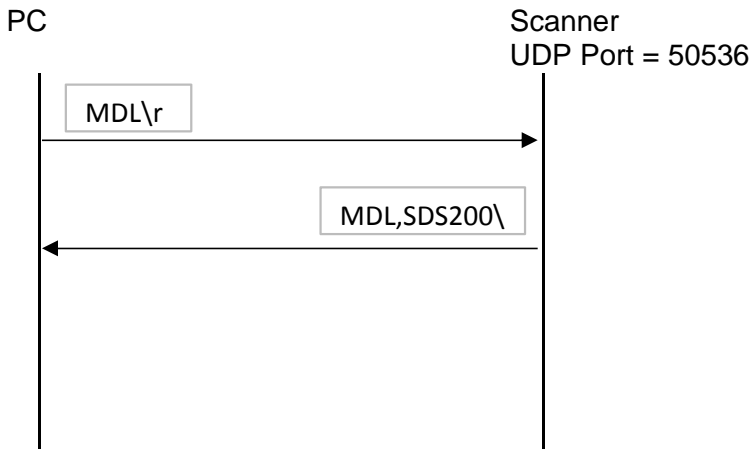
1. Summary

Virtual Serial on Network protocol defines virtual serial service.
This protocol uses **UDP Port 50536** for compatibility BCD536HP.

See "Remote Command Specification" for remote command.

If you send packet which remote command is written to,
scanner will return response of remote command.
You don't need negotiation. You don't need protocol header.

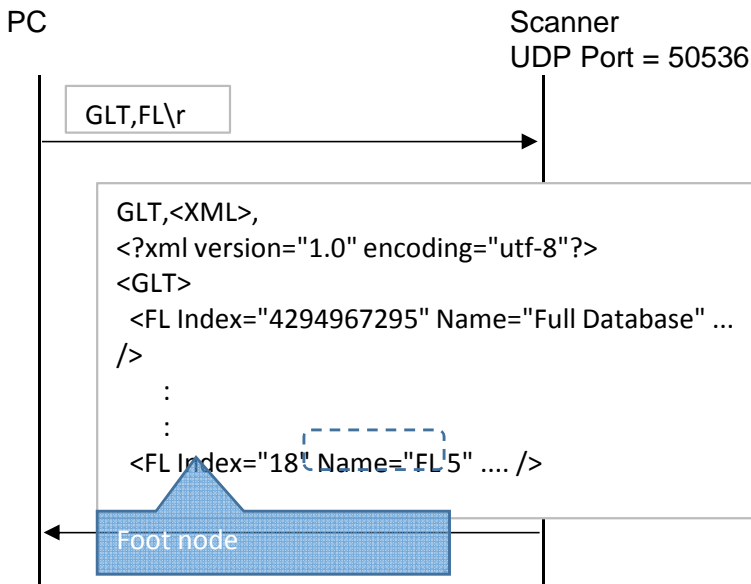
2. Normal Remote command

Response of XML are dividd multi packets.

Watch EOT attribute of Foot node to judge last packet.
Watch No attribute of Foot node to check lost packet.
Retry request, if packet is lost.
